When the Mag-Boosta devices were first available, I put one on my 1999 Suzuki Grand Vitara. I never kept close track of fuel usage as I drive a combination of long and short trips that vary all the time. In my case there is no reference MPG to go by.

But, that said, California requires regular exhaust emissions tests. Due to the age of my car, it was automatically listed as a "gross polluter" and was assigned to more stringent tests. The state does this to force old vehicles to be scrapped.

After putting on the Mag-Boosta, the car's test results started getting BETTER instead of degrading. By the time I sold the car in 2021 the test results were essentially perfect, much better than a brand new car!

I installed a Mag-Boosta on my new car about 2 days after buying it. So, again I have no reference MPG and I still drive a random mix of short and long trips. But, my fuel mileage according to the car's dashboard is better than the factory advertised number for mixed driving. Also, when brand new the engine was noisy but now hums like a happy engine.
